Biographical Note

Warder Cadbury was an associate professor in Philosophy at the University of Albany. Interested in Adirondack history, he served as a research associate at the Adirondack Museum as well as president of the Hamilton County (NY) Historical Society. He authored a book on artist Arthur Fitzwilliam Tait and a historical introduction to the reprint of W.H.H. Murray's classic of 1869, Adventures in the Wilderness.

Collection Description

The Warder H. Cadbury Sheet Music Collection consists of sheet music of mostly hunting songs which range in date from c1798 to 1914. The pieces were collected by Cadbury as a by-product of his sporting hobbies and research into Adirondack history. Many of these items appear to have been removed from bound volumes. A few titles include multiple copies; these are generally versions printed by another printer or revised at a later date. A folder labeled Miscellaneous contains an original cover and two photocopies displaying artwork that Cadbury felt was appealing; however, only the covers are present, not the actual music. The items in this collection have been arranged alphabetically by song title. The dates given for the pieces have been gleaned from Robert Henderson's Early American Sport (1977).
