Biographical Note

"Lost Treasure" was a chestnut Thoroughbred that saw greater success at stud than as a racer. Born in 1951, he was from Menow out of Idle Quest by *Sir Gallahad III. After a few victories on the amateur circuit in Maryland, "Lost Treasure" stood as stud on the farm of William T. C. Rogers of Leesburg, Virginia for nearly twenty years. He was last listed in the *Blood-Horse Stallion Register* for the 1977 season, and most likely died around that time.

Collection Description

The "Lost Treasure" Stud Fee Account Ledger consists of one volume of stud fees earned by the stallion for the William T. C. Rogers Farm in Leesburg from 1957 to 1962.
