**Historical Note**

The Riding and Hunt Club of Washington DC was founded in the early 20<sup>th</sup> Century. This club includes riding, hunting, polo and horse shows. Both men and women from all over the United States participate in the Hunt Club throughout the entire year. It is located in Washington, between Rock Creek and Potomac Parks. There are outdoor, as well as indoor, opportunities for horsemen to enjoy their sport.
