### Historical Note

The Mill Creek Hunt was founded in 1897 as the Onwentsia Club in Lake Forest, IL. It began as a "paper chase" and was turned into a "drag" hunt around 1904. The hunt was re-established in 1920 and moved to Milburn, IL in 1930 under the name of the Mill Creek Hunt Club.

Mill Creek Hunt was fortunate to have among its membership the famous architect David Adler, who designed stables, a main house and kennels for the club. The hunt went dormant during World War II, and re-established regular hunting in 1947 and 1948. Located north of Chicago, Mill Creek today follows hounds over much of the same country it started with: over seven thousand acres of rolling, wooded farmland divided by creeks. Coops, log fences and post and rails dot the countryside.

The Mill Creek Hunt Archive was donated to NSLM in 2002 by Dorr Bradley Carpenter (1928-2009) of Stanardsville, Virginia, a longtime resident of Lake Forest. Dorr attended North Shore Country Day School, Proctor Academy, and graduated from St. Lawrence University. For many years he was a member of the Mill Creek Hunt Club. He was a pilot and FAA inspector, and was the author of books on antique Ryan airplanes, the history of Japanese submarines and numerous magazine articles on motorcycles and firearms.

### Collection Description

The Mill Creek Hunt Archive consists of letters, clippings, photographs, official documents, and hunting records that document the activities of the Mill Creek Hunt from 1923 through 1967. Also included are membership lists of the Mill Creek Hunt, Longmeadow Hunt, Fox River Valley Hunt, Milwaukee Hunt, Oak Brook Hounds, and the Wayne-Dupage Hunt.
