Biographical Note

William Almy, Jr. (1900-1979) was a Massachusetts sportsman and Master of Fox Hounds. He was master and huntsman of the Quansett Hounds, with country overlooking Rhode Island Sound, Almy was only 22 years old when he was elected to membership in the MFHA. Almost 30 years later, having hunted packs of English, Crossbred, and American hounds in Quansett, Myopia and Groton (all in Massachusetts) and Culpeper and Warrenton (in Virginia), Almy had achieved a reputation as the leading amateur huntsman in North America. He was a much sought-after judge for hound shows and horse shows (including the National Horse Show) and was kept busy as a steward at race meets around the country.
