**Collection Description**

James Reynolds (1891-1957) was a painter and illustrator active in New York City and in Loudoun County, VA. He specialized in horses; examples of his work include the 1941 watercolor *Blockade, by Man o' War* and the 1940 work *Groom Leading Two Horses*. He wrote and illustrated *A World of Horses*, published in New York City by Creative Age Press in 1947. Reynolds died in 1957.

This collection includes correspondence between Reynolds and Mrs. Samuel E. (June) Badger of Middleburg. Most of the correspondence is related to the inclusion of Reynolds' artwork in the *Chronicle of the Horse*. Several photographs of Reynolds' art are included, as are several original, informal pencil drawings.
