Tour the National Sporting Library and Museum

The National Sporting Library and Museum was founded in 1954 to highlight the heritage and tradition of country pursuits like steeplechasing, foxhunting, polo, horsemanship and more. The exhibit currently on display is "Nic Fiddian Green: Spiritus Equus." It celebrates British artist Nic Fiddian Green's vision with five works installed in outdoor locations, including 18 sculptures and seven drawings. The exhibit is the artist's first retrospective of equine subjects ever presented.
