**National Sporting Library and Museum Announces New Board Members**

MIDDLEBURG, VA – Three candidates have been elected to the NSLM Board of Directors in 2012. The board welcomes **Claire Reid** of Southern Pines, North Carolina, **B. Tim Brookshire** of Tyler, Texas, and **Guy O. Dove** of Middleburg, Virginia.

**Claire Reid** has a long association with the NSLM as she has participated in all three coaching events in 2004, 2007 and 2011. She is a member of the World Coaching Club and competes in driving events. Reid has spent her working career in the technology industry as a programmer working her way up to CIO. She joined Bearing Point where she became a partner in their consulting division. She then started a technology firm as president which was eventually sold to a technology investment firm. She was recruited into Oracle Corporation where she ran their Public Sector consulting services in North

America and wound up her career at Oracle during the company's very ambitious seven year period which included the acquisition of Sun Microsystems.

**B. Tim Brookshire** lives in Texas with his wife Michelle and family. He is an active sportsman who enjoys hunting, fishing, wingshooting and hiking. Brookshire has had a varied career which began in banking and real estate. While the Brookshire family resides in Texas, they also own a home in Upperville, Virginia.
